What is OASys?

It is the way we assess you

- to find out why you offend
- to find out what your needs are
- to help write a report to advise the Courts
- to help make a sentence plan
- to help you make changes to your life so that you are less likely to offend again

The OASys Process

You will

- have an interview
- be asked to complete a question sheet about yourself
- be able to discuss the way you see yourself
- be given a copy of the sentence plan
- have reviews to see what progress you are making

What should you do?

- interviews and be ready to take an active part
- Ask questions
- Complete the list of questions about yourself
- Think about your answers to the questions. This is your chance to comment on your life and why you offend. It is a time for you to help plan your sentence
- This is a plan about what you are going to do to change your life and make it less likely that you will offend again
